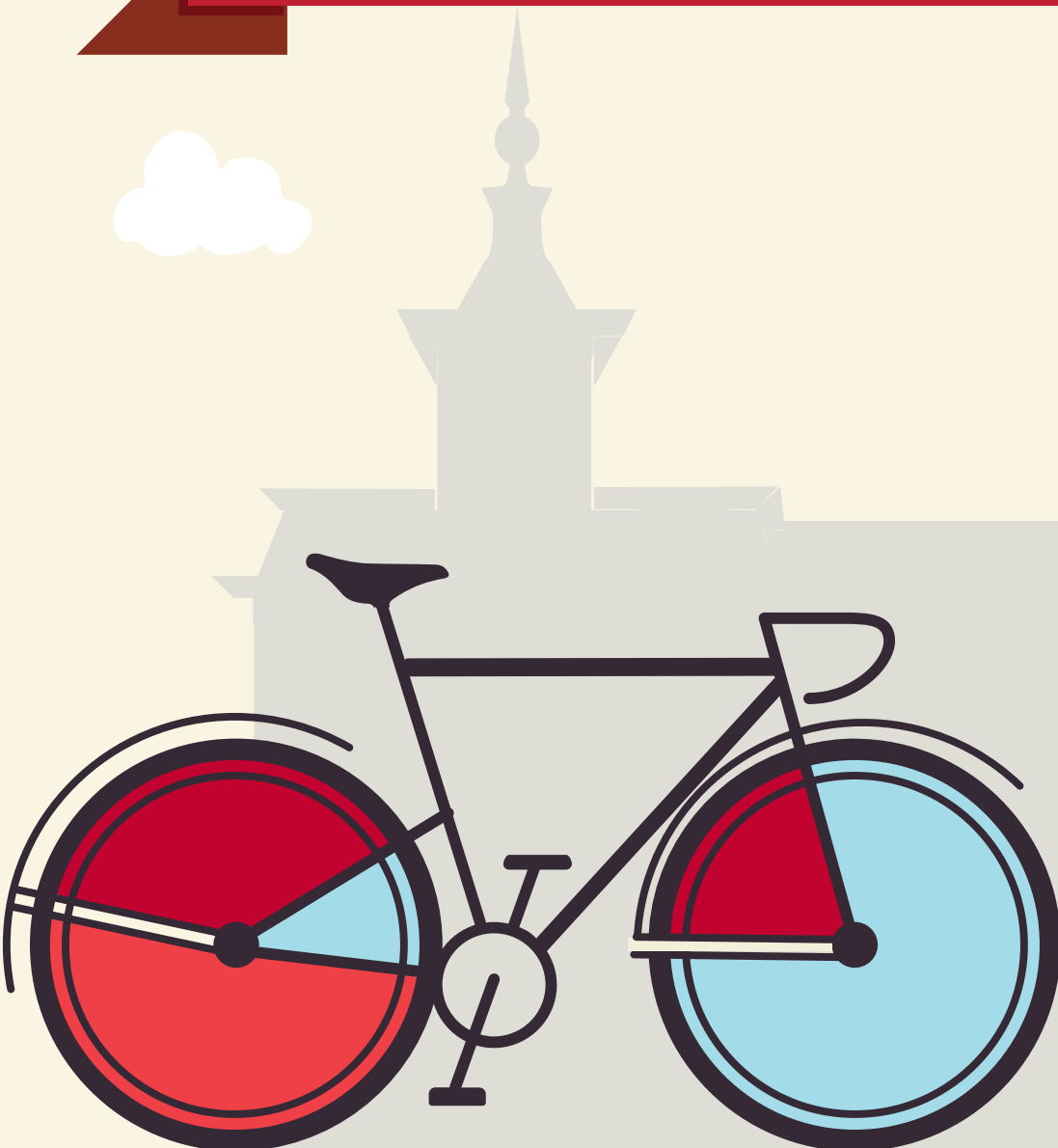

- College Transfer Credits are courses taken at a college or university after graduating high school and not earned through AP, IB, or CLEP.
- Only 64 semester hours (96 quarter hours) may transfer from a 2-yr college. Developmental courses (under 100-level) do not transfer.
- Requirements met through an eligible A.A. or A.S. degree may also be met with an eligible A.A.S. degree only if applied to the B.A.S. degree.
- Students with less than 28 transferable hours will need to complete CARD 110, a 1-credit transition course.
