

## Office of Residence Life North Central College Study Abroad Housing Information

Congratulations on your decision to study abroad! Studying abroad is an amazing opportunity to experience another culture and gain a better understanding of yourself and the world. We look forward to having you live on campus either before you depart or when you return from your study abroad experience.

If you plan to study abroad and you wish to live on campus either before you leave to study abroad or when you return from studying abroad, you will need to do the following <u>before</u> you depart:

- 1. If you plan to study abroad during the Fall term, please complete the *Study Abroad Intention Form* and the *Study Abroad Roommate Questionnaire* and return them to the Office of Residence Life before Housing Selection (May 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>). These forms are attached to this sheet. Extra copies will also be available at Housing Selection. Although you will not be able to select a roommate or a specific room, you will be able to state your preferences and provide us with some information to hopefully best match you with a roommate when you return.
- 2. If you plan to study abroad in the Winter and/or Spring, and you plan to live on campus in the Fall, you must attend Housing Selection to select a room. More information about Housing Selection will be sent to the campus community after Spring Break 2016.
- 3. **In either case, you will need to e-sign your 2015-2016 room and board agreement on Merlin.** You must submit your materials and e-sign your room and board agreement to ensure that you are guaranteed a space on campus for the Fall or when you return.

If you have questions or concerns about how to guarantee your campus housing, please do not hesitate to contact the Office of Residence Life at 630-637-5858. Failure to submit your intention form, questionnaire, and to e-sign your room and board agreement may result in our inability to offer you campus housing upon your return from studying abroad.

Please note that when our housing demand is very high we often lease apartments off-campus. Your housing upon returning from study abroad may be in an on-campus residence hall or in a North Central College leased apartment.
