

ART PORTFOLIO REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

In addition to Art Scholarship Reviews, students may also complete a review for Interactive Media Studies and audition for Music, Jazz, Forensic and Theatre Scholarships.

ART REVIEW DATE

Saturday, February 10th, 2018

Students wishing to interview for an Art Scholarship should come prepared with a **portfolio including a minimum of 10 examples** of the student's best original, recent artwork.

- Present work in a portfolio case AND/OR send in advance 10 35-mm color slides or 10 digital photos on CD-ROM. Photographic documentation should be sent through the North Central College BOX account, and must be received by Monday, Feb. 5, 2018 for best consideration in the reviews. Contact Professor Christine Rabenold regarding carrying 3-D work to the review at (630)-637-5543.

The following items should be **mailed or faxed** to the Art Department **prior** to the interviews. If you register for a review after the priority date, please bring these materials in duplicate to your portfolio review appointment.

- **Two Letters of Recommendation from school Art Instructors** (One letter will be accepted from students who attend smaller schools.)
- **Letter of Intent** (This letter should clearly state the student's plans for their first year at North Central College, both in terms of academic and co-curricular life, and goals related to the study of Art at North Central.)
- **Resume of school, work, and especially Art, experience**
