The Education Department prefers that EDN 101 be taken at North Central College. A minimum of 120 total credit hours are required to graduate. Each course can be used for only one licensure requirement. A score of 22 on the ACT with writing OR composite score of 1030 on the SAT (critical reading+mathematics=1030 or higher) and a minimum 450 on writing OR a passing score on the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP test) is required. If the SAT is taken March 6, 2016 or later the composite score required is 1110 (evidence based reading and writing +mathematics) with 26 or higher on writing and
