Students should consult the Education Handbook and online undergraduate catalog for specific requirements for the major, endorsements, and certification/licensure. Students seeking K-12 or secondary certification must satisfy: academic major, general education requirements, and State of Illinois certification requirements for grades K-12 or 9-12. Note, only PSY 100 and nine other credit hours of professional education may be transferred in from a two-year college. The Education Department prefers that EDN 101 be taken at North Central College. A typical student will need over 120 total credit hours to graduate. Refer to content area for more information. A score of 22 on the ACT with writing OR composite score of 1030 on the SAT (critical reading+mathematics=1030 or higher) and a minimum 450 on writing OR a passing score on the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP test) is required. If the SAT is taken March 6, 2016 or later the composite score required is 1110 (evidence based reading and writing +mathematics) with 26 or higher on writing and language.
