Admission Requirements

- An earned MSN from a CCNE or ACEN master accredited program
- A current, unencumbered registered RN license
- A cumulative GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale for the last 60 hours of their MSN program

Steps

Submit all below listed materials to grad@noctrl.edu or by mail to the North Central College, School of Graduate and Professional Studies, 30 N. Brainard Street, Naperville IL 60540

- 1. Complete attached PDF form
- 2. Submitted official post-secondary academic transcripts
 - a. Official transcripts must be submitted to the School of Graduate and Professional Studies directly from the institution attended. Official transcripts can be sent by mail or electronically from verified services. Hard copy transcripts hand-delivered by students will be accepted if received in an official sealed envelope from the institution.
- 3. Submit resume/CV with academic and work history, certificates and services
- 4. Submit three signed recommendation forms
 - a. At least one from a professional nurse colleague (supervisor or preceptor) and one from a professor or graduate-level prepared nursing colleague who can address the applicant's professional and/or academic qualifications
- 5. Personal narrative optional; interview can be used in lieu of personal narrative

Interviews

Virtual or on campus interviews will be conducted for all applicants. Extended interviews will be conducted for applicants who opt out of personal narrative.
