

To create a clear pathway for students at College of DuPage to transfer to and complete their Bachelor's degree at North Central College, this agreement outlines admission standards, transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations.

1. Transferring students must complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree prior to enrolling at North Central College.
2. Submit a completed Guaranteed Admission Agreement Participation form (<https://www.northcentralcollege.edu/transfer/guaranteed-admission-agreement/participation>).
3. Maintain a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of a 2.5.
4. A maximum of 64 transferable credit hours will be accepted by North Central College from a community college. Students with more than 64 hours can still fulfill institutional requirements, but will not gain any additional credit hours beyond 64.
5. Students must be in good standing at College of DuPage at the time of transfer.
6. Students are eligible to transfer into more than 60 undergraduate degree programs at North Central College * (Appendix A)
7. Students who achieve a transferrable GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, and have participated in the Honors Program at College of DuPage, will have guaranteed admission to the Honors Program at North Central College. Additional application materials are required to be admitted into the Honors Program.
8. North Central College and College of DuPage may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for COD students the programs, policies, and procedures relevant to this agreement. This agreement will be publicized in newsletters, course schedules, and other promotional materials.
9. Failure to meet the requirements of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement does not preclude any student from applying and being considered for admission to North Central College using the traditional admission process.

Other Terms

10. Courses numbered lower than the 100-level and courses not deemed transferable according to the established articulation guide are not included in this agreement.
11. This agreement does not guarantee admission for students seeking readmission to North Central College.
12. *There are additional requirements for admission to the Education majors per state requirements that will have to be reviewed with the student prior to transferring. Admission to the Education program requires a 2.75 GPA and no grade below a C- in education-required courses will be accepted.

13. North Central College will provide College of DuPage an annual snapshot of student enrollment data for those COD participants in the Guaranteed Admission Agreement, subject to compliance with FERPA or other applicable provisions of law by both parties.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary.

This agreement may be terminated by North Central College or College of DuPage with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice one year prior to intended change.
