



Campus Move Out: Do the Right Thing

Reduce. Reuse. Recycle. Relocate.



Each year during Move Out, NCC continues its efforts to keep reusable and hazardous items out of the landfill. There are recycling programs for items including electronics and carpet. Donations of food, clothing and furniture are also accepted. The purpose is to make sure these items end up where they belong, either properly disposed of or reused.

Look out for the following collection programs during Move Out week:

Electronics Recycling:

Bins are located in each residence hall lounge. Any unwanted electronics should be placed inside these designated bins.

- **Acceptable items include:** Computers/Laptops, televisions, printers, VCR/DVD players, stereos, microwaves, toner/ink cartridges, gaming consoles, and cell phones.

Carpet Recycling:

Drop off locations for carpet will be located in each residence hall lounge as well. We only ask that the carpet get rolled up before it is brought down.

Furniture Donations:

We can only take items that are still in good condition. If a student has any furniture to donate, please contact the Sustainability Coordinator to set up a pick up time. She can be reached at bdgraham@noctrl.edu or 630-637-5623.

Clothes Donations:

Collections boxes located in each residence hall lounge will accept any clothes that are in good enough condition to be reused AND clothes that are poor quality to be recycled into rags or carpet padding. Shoes and purses are also accepted.

Food Donations:

Students can donate any un-opened food by placing items in the Loaves and Fishes donation bins. Black bins for food collections will be located in the lounge area of each residence hall. If there is food that is either opened or expired, it can be brought to Kaufman to be composted.

Kaufman "Amnesty" Program:

A box will be placed at the entrance of Kaufman Dining Hall and in each residence hall lounge. Here, students can return any items "borrowed" from the dining hall, no questions asked.
