



# What is Directory Information at NCC?

Directory information is student information that can be disclosed to a third party without consent from the student or notification to the student.

**North Central College considers the following to be Directory Information:**

- Name, address, phone
- Date and place of birth
- College assigned e-mail
- Dates of enrollment
- Enrollment status
- Class level (i.e. first-year)
- Participation in activities/sports
- Height and weight of athletes
- Photo/video for NCC publications
- Previous educational institution(s) attended
- Degrees/Awards conferred

“Directory information is information contained in an educational record of a student which would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed.”  
(FERPA Regulations, Code of Federal Regulations, Title 34, Part 99.3)

All student data that is not on the list of Directory Information is considered Non-Directory Information.
