

Guaranteed Admission Agreement North Central College and Elgin Community College



To create a clear pathway for students at Elgin Community College to transfer to and complete their Bachelor's degree at North Central College, this agreement outlines admission standards, transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations.

- 1. Transferring students must complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree prior to enrolling at North Central College.
- 2. Submit a completed Guaranteed Admission Agreement Participation form.
- 3. Maintain a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of a 2.5.
- 4. A maximum of 64 transferable credit hours will be accepted by North Central College from a community college. Students with more than 64 hours can still fulfill institutional requirements, but will not gain any additional credit hours beyond 64.
- 5. Students must be in good standing at Elgin Community College at the time of transfer.
- 6. Students are eligible to transfer into more than 55 undergraduate degree programs at North Central College *
- 7. North Central College and Elgin Community College may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for Elgin students the programs, policies, and procedures relevant to this agreement. This agreement will be publicized in newsletters, course schedules, and other promotional materials.
- 8. Failure to meet the requirements of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement does not preclude any student from applying and being considered for admission to North Central College using the traditional admission process.

Other Terms

- Courses numbered lower than the 100-level and courses not deemed transferable according to the established articulation guide are not included in this agreement.
- 10. This agreement does not guarantee admission for students seeking readmission to North Central College.
- 11. *There are additional requirements for admission to the Education majors per state requirements that will have to be reviewed with the student prior to transferring. Admission to the Education program requires a 2.75 GPA and no grade below a C- in education-required courses will be accepted.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary.

This agreement may be terminated by North Central College or Elgin Community College with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice one year prior to intended change.

North Central College and Elgin Community College official authorizes this agreement on tb^2 Day of April 2019, with this agreement becoming effective immediately.
