What is Directory Information?

Can be disclosed without student consent

Information such as student name, address, phone, class level (i.e. first-year,) enrollment status (i.e. full-time), and degrees/ awards conferred are considered **Directory Information**. For more details, scan the QR code at left.



What is Non-Directory Information?

Can be disclosed only with permission from the student Information such as grades, GPA, specific courses taken, daily class schedule, citizenship, gender, and ethnicity are **Non-Directory Information**. For more details, scan the OR code at left.

- Will it be phone? Text? Email?
- What will they want to know about, and what are you willing to share? (academics, physical health, mental health, co-curricular involvement, etc.)
