



Guaranteed Admission Agreement North Central College and McHenry County College

To create a clear pathway for students at McHenry County College to transfer to and complete their Bachelor's degree at North Central College, this agreement outlines admission standards, transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations.

- 1. Transferring students must complete an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree prior to enrolling at North Central College.
- 2. Maintain a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of a 2.5.
- 3. A maximum of 64 transferable credit hours will be accepted by North Central College from a community college. Students with more than 64 hours can still fulfill institutional requirements, but will not gain any additional credit hours beyond 64.
- 4. Students must be in good standing at McHenry County College at the time of transfer.
- 5. Students are eligible to transfer into more than 55 undergraduate degree programs at North Central College *
- 6. Students admitted through the Guaranteed Admission Agreement will be awarded a \$2,000 scholarship in addition to any other merit awards they have received.
- 7. Students authorize North Central College and McHenry County College to share their educational records by signing the participation form.
- 8. Students will be subject to the catalog edition based on their entry term.
- 9. North Central College and McHenry County College may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for McHenry students the programs, policies, and procedures relevant to this agreement. This agreement will be publicized in materials such as newsletters, flyers, and other promotional materials. In addition, North Central College and McHenry County College will post details about the Guaranteed Admission Agreement on their websites. North Central College and McHenry County College have the right to review all advertising for the agreement.
- 10. Failure to meet the requirements of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement does not preclude any student from applying and being considered for admission to North Central College using the traditional admission process.

Other Terms

- 11. Courses numbered lower than the 100-level and courses not deemed transferable according to the established articulation guide are not included in this agreement.
- 12. This agreement does not guarantee admission for students seeking readmission to North Central College.

- 13. *There are additional requirements for admission to the Education majors per state requirements that will have to be reviewed with the student prior to transferring. Admission to the Education program requires a 2.75 GPA and no grade below a C- in education-required courses will be accepted.
- 14. McHenry County College agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold North Central College, its affiliates, trustees, directors, officers, faculty, employees, and agents, past or present, harmless from and against all claims, causes of action, fees, liabilities, damages, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) and costs relating to or arising from or based upon the negligent or willful acts or omissions of McHenry County College, its employees or its agents. North Central College agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold McHenry County College, its affiliates, trustees, directors, officers, faculty, employees, and agents, past or present, harmless from and against all claims, causes of action, fees, liabilities, damages, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) and costs relating to or arising from or based upon the negligent or willful acts or omissions of North Central College, its employees or its agents.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary.

This agreement may be terminated by North Central College or McHenry County College with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice one year prior to Intended change.

Should the program be dissolved, students who are participating at that time will be guaranteed transfer into North Central College provided they satisfy all program requirements.

North Central College and McHenry County College official authorizes this agreement on Day of April, 2019, with this agreement becoming effective immediately.
