The North Central College Master of Physician Assistant Studies (NCC MSPAS) program candidates are required to have a minimum of 15 hours of direct observation of a certified physician assistant. The application will not be considered complete, and will not proceed to admissions committee review, without hand-written signatures from both the PA Candidate and PA-C. The NCC MSPAS PA Shadowing Form is the only form that may be used to document PA shadowing hours, and must be submitted by the PA Candidate prior to the 12/31/2021. No additional hour updates will be accepted after 12/31/2021. This form is to be used to describe your experience with *each* Physician Assistant you have directly observed. Upload one form for each PA-C you have shadowed to your CASPA application, or e-mail to Grad@noctrl.edu if CASPA has closed.
