

Guaranteed Admission Agreement North Central College and Triton College



To create a clear pathway for students at Triton College to transfer to and complete their Bachelor's degree at North Central College, this Agreement outlines admission standards, transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations.

- 1. Transferring students must complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree prior to enrolling at North Central College.
- 2. As a requirement for participation in the Agreement, students must provide North Central College and Triton College with a signed, written authorization, to disclose the other institution the students' educational records, including, but not limited to, academics, admission, financial aid, and advising information, as appropriate. (Appendix A)
- 3. Maintain a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of a 2.5.
- 4. A maximum of 64 transferable credit hours will be accepted by North Central College from a community college. Students with more than 64 hours can still fulfill institutional requirements, but will not gain any additional credit hours beyond 64.
- 5. Students must be in good standing at Triton College at the time of transfer.
- 6. Students are eligible to transfer into more than 55 undergraduate degree programs at North Central College * (Appendix B)
- 7. Students who achieve a transferrable GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, and have participated in the Honors Program at Triton College, will have Guaranteed Admission to the College Scholars Honors Program at North Central College. Additional application materials are required to be admitted into the Honors Program.
- 8. North Central College and Triton College may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for Triton students the programs, policies, and procedures relevant to this Agreement. This Agreement will be publicized in newsletters, course schedules, and other promotional materials.
- 9. Failure to meet the requirements of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement does not preclude any student from applying and being considered for admission to North Central College using the traditional admission process.

Other Terms

- 10. Courses numbered lower than the 100-level and courses not deemed transferable according to the established articulation guide are not included in this Agreement.
- 11. This Agreement does not guarantee admission for students seeking readmission to North Central College.
- 12. *There are additional requirements for admission to the Education majors per state requirements that will have to be reviewed with the student prior to transferring.

- Admission to the Education program requires a 2.75 GPA and no grade below a C- in education-required courses will be accepted.
- 13. North Central College will provide Triton College an annual snapshot of student enrollment data for those Triton participants in the Guaranteed Admission Agreement, subject to compliance with FERPA or other applicable provisions of law by both parties.
- 14. Each party agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the other, its officers, agents, trustees and employees against any losses, damages, judgments, claims, expenses, costs and liabilities imposed upon or incurred by or asserted against the party, its officers, agents, trustees or employees, including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses, arising out of the acts or omissions of the other party, its officers, agents or employees, under this Agreement.

Triton College, as an entity and on behalf of its employees, agents, and students, claims any and all governmental immunity as may be established by or set forth under Federal or Illinois law, rule or regulation.

- 15. This Agreement is executed by an authorized representative of Triton College in the representative's official capacity only and the representative shall have no personal liability under this Agreement.
- 16. Each party represents that it possesses all professional or business licenses and accreditation required by law, if any, and all qualifications necessary to fully perform its obligations.
- 17. Neither party shall discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, physical or mental handicap, an unfavorable discharge from military service, or any other factor as prohibited by law. Each party certifies that it is an equal opportunity employer.
- 18. Each party certifies that it maintains a written sexual harassment policy in conformance with 775 ILCS 5/2-105 and a Drug Free Workplace in compliance with the Drug Free Workplace Act.
- 19. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive laws of the State of Illinois regardless of any conflict of laws provision. All disputes arising out of this Agreement, wherever derived, will be resolved in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary. All changes shall be in writing and signed by an authorized agent of each party.

This agreement may be terminated by North Central College or Triton College with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice one year prior to intended change.

North Central College and Triton College official authorizes this Agreement, in their official capacity only, on

21st Day of October, 2020, with this Agreement becoming effective immediately.
