



**Guaranteed Admission Agreement
North Central College and Oakton Community College**



**NORTH CENTRAL

To create a clear pathway for students at Oakton Community College to transfer to and complete their Bachelor's degree at North Central College, this agreement outlines admission standards, transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations.

1. Transferring students must complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree prior to enrolling at North Central College.
2. As a requirement for participation in the Agreement, students must provide North Central College and Oakton Community College with a signed, written authorization to disclose the other institution the students' educational records, including, but not limited to, academics, admission, financial aid, and advising information, as appropriate. (Appendix A)
3. Maintain a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of a 2.5.
4. A maximum of 64 transferable credit hours will be accepted by North Central College from a community college. Students with more than 64 hours can still fulfill institutional requirements, but will not gain any additional credit hours beyond 64.
5. Students must be in good standing at Oakton Community College at the time of transfer.
6. Students are eligible to transfer into more than 55 undergraduate degree programs at North Central College * (Appendix B)
7. Students who achieve a transferrable GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, and have participated in the Honors Program at Oakton Community College, will have Guaranteed Admission to the College Scholars Honors Program at North Central College. Additional application materials are required to be admitted into the Honors Program.
8. North Central College and Oakton Community College may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for Oakton students the programs, policies, and procedures relevant to this agreement. This agreement will be publicized in newsletters, course schedules, and other promotional materials.
9. Failure to meet the requirements of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement does not preclude any student from applying and being considered for admission to North Central College using the traditional admission process.

Other Terms

10. Courses numbered lower than the 100-level and courses not deemed transferable according to the established articulation guide are not included in this agreement.
11. This agreement does not guarantee admission for students seeking readmission to North Central College.
12. *There are additional requirements for admission to the Education majors perstate requirements that will have to be reviewed with the student prior to transferring.

Admission to the Education program requires a 2.75 GPA and no grade below a C- in education-required courses will be accepted.

13. North Central College will provide Oakton Community College an annual snapshot of student enrollment data for those Oakton participants in the Guaranteed Admission Agreement, subject to compliance with FERPA or other applicable provisions of law by both parties.


This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary.

This agreement may be terminated by North Central College or Oakton Community College with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice one year prior to intended change.


North Central College and Oakton Community College official authorizes this agreement on



The Guaranteed Admission Agreement allows students the opportunity to be simultaneously admitted to both North Central College and Oakton Community College.

General Guidelines

Students indicate their intention to participate in the program by filling out this form at the time of their application to North Central College. International students must also complete this form to formally apply for the program even if a conditional letter of acceptance to North Central College was issued at the point of application to Oakton Community College. This form should be submitted at least one year in advance of the student's first semester at North Central College. Guaranteed admission students are subject to the same admission and degree requirements, as well as the same academic policies governing all other North Central College and Oakton Community College students.

Instructions

- Step 1:** Meet with your academic advisor at Oakton Community College to verify eligibility to apply
- Step 2:** Complete the application for admission to North Central College
