### **NCC-in-Costa Rica**

- Earn 6-7 credits of Spanish
- Complete 2-3 internship credits; internship is based on your interests and goals
- Earn 3 credits of GLS credit; course is taught by an accompanying NCC professor
- Field trip to Nicaragua included in program fee
- Live with host families in Quepos and San Jose

### **Universidad de Granada (CLM)**

- Earn 6-15 credits of Spanish
- Courses taught in Spanish and English
- Complete an internship for credit within the fields of business, education or service learning
- Live with a host family
- Options to engage in various cultural activities including Flamenco dance and guitar workshops, films and photo competitions
