



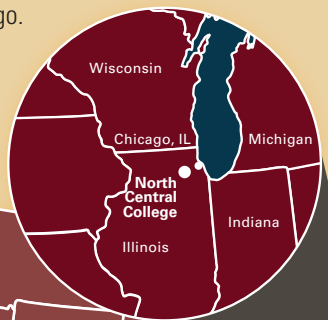

The English Language Institute (ELI)

is a year-round intensive English program for ESL students at North Central College, a private university located in Naperville, Illinois, 45 kilometers from downtown Chicago. Founded in 1861, North Central College is a four-year university that offers bachelor's degrees in more than 55 academic programs and master's degrees in six areas.

North Central's beautiful campus is located in a quiet residential neighborhood just a two-minute walk from downtown Naperville, a safe and friendly city of more than 144,600. The university is also within walking distance of the train station where trains leave every hour to and from Chicago.

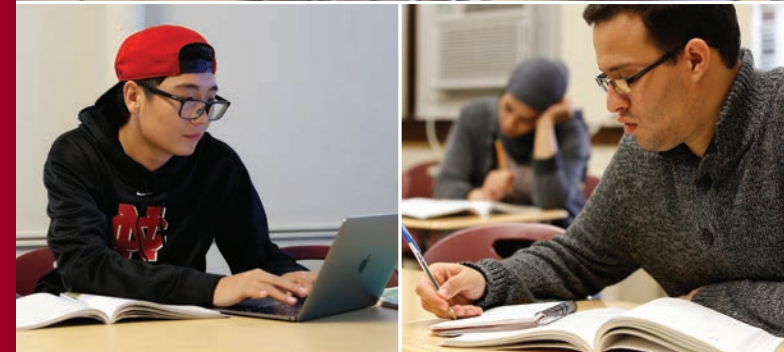

Student Life

The ELI helps students learn English by connecting them to activities and events, both on campus and locally. The International Club includes U.S. and international students and hosts many events, outings and meetings every term. Students can participate in academic and cultural trips to Chicago and get to know the local community through activities like service learning, Friendship Families and Conversation Partners. These opportunities help students learn English faster and create lifelong relationships.

Housing and Meals

ELI students live with undergraduate students in residence halls and have full access to all services and facilities. Students choose a meal plan that fits their schedules, and students have access to foods prepared according to cultural and dietary needs. The dining hall is also a wonderful place to learn about classmates and practice English.

Visa Options

- **F-1 visa students** may enroll full time in the ELI, fulfilling government requirements.
- **Students on other nonimmigrant visas** may enroll according to the regulations governing each visa.
- **Community members** may enroll as full- or part-time students.

Application Checklist

Eight weeks before the start of the term, ELI applicants must submit:

- Completed and signed application form with \$100 application fee
- Copy of passport identification page
- Proof of financial support (for F-1 visa students)
- Appropriate visa information (see ELI Application, page 2)
- Optional documents: TOEFL/IELTS score report, high school/university transcripts/diploma
- Additional admission documents required for transfer students and U.S. permanent residents.
