INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions carefully and enter ALL persons required on the front of this form.

Attending a college/university: Persons can only be included as attending college who will be going to college between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020. Include only students enrolling (or who are accepted for enrollment) for at least 6 credit hours in at least one term. If the school uses clock hours, include only students attending at least 12 clock hours per week. The student must be working towards a degree or certificate leading to a recognized education credential at a college that is eligible to participate in any of the federal student aid programs.

Definition of Support: The word "support" means one-half of all basic maintenance costs for the entire 12-month period (July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020). This could be full support for at least 6 months or half-support for 12 months. Items considered as support include, but are not limited to, money, gifts, loans, housing, food, clothes, car, medical and dental care, payment of college costs, etc.

Who is Included?

1. **You** should always be included.
2. **Your spouse** should be included. (If you are divorced, separated or widowed, do not include information about your spouse.)
3. Include **your children** regardless of where they live, if you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
4. Include your **unborn child**, if that child will be born before July 1, 2019 and you will provide more than half of the child's support from the projected date of birth to July 1, 2020.
5. Include **other persons, if** they lived with you **and** received more than one-half of their support from you at the time of application, and you will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
