



## Dear Teachers of Chinese,

The North Central College Chinese department has secured a STARTALK grant which will provide funding for a Chinese Teacher Program for 12 pre-service and in-service teachers of Chinese language. This year's theme is Integrating Authentic Materials, Effective Teaching Strategies and Technology, and will focus on how to use mixed media and other cultural tools in the classroom to teach Mandarin Chinese. The Chinese Teacher Program will use both a combination of online and face-to-face workshops to provide professional development opportunities for teachers. The on-site meetings and online modules will be led by nationally known teacher trainers, experienced high school teachers, and college professors.

The dates of the STARTALK Chinese Teacher Program will take place from June 14 to June 29, 2019. The program, with a total instructional time of over 90 hours, combines a 10-day face-to-face workshop and 5 online modules, to guide participants to use authentic materials and apply effective teaching strategies in unit and lesson planning. To ensure the continued support for participants' application of training content, two post-program reunion and sharing activities are designed during the fall and winter. The expected outcomes are that participants are able to select age-appropriate authentic materials for their lessons, scaffold student learning through effective teaching strategies and tools, and develop performance- based assessment using authentic materials. We also hope this year's teacher program encourages current and future language teachers to venture into adapting STARTALK principles to achieve robust classroom dynamics.
