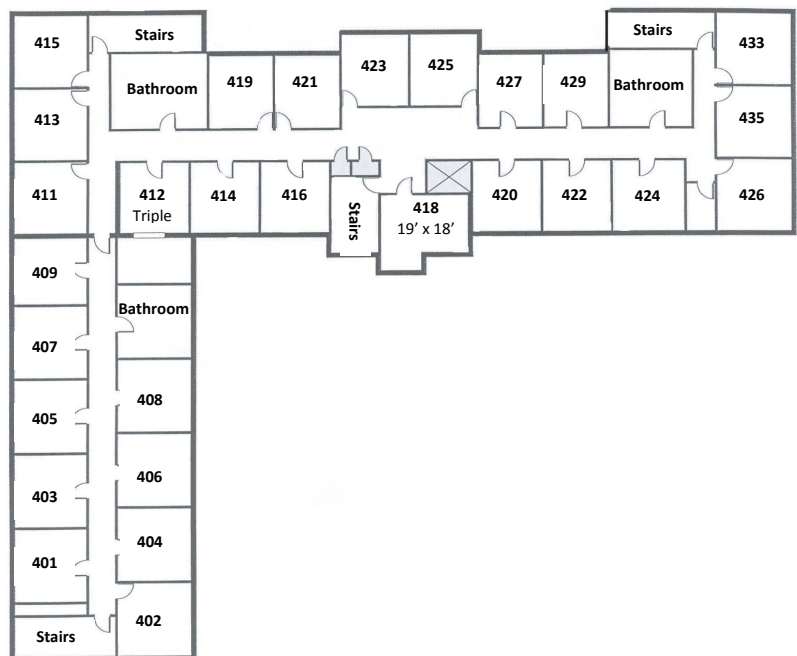
WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF LIVING IN INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY HOUSING?

NORTH CENTRAL COLLEGE CAMPUS MAP

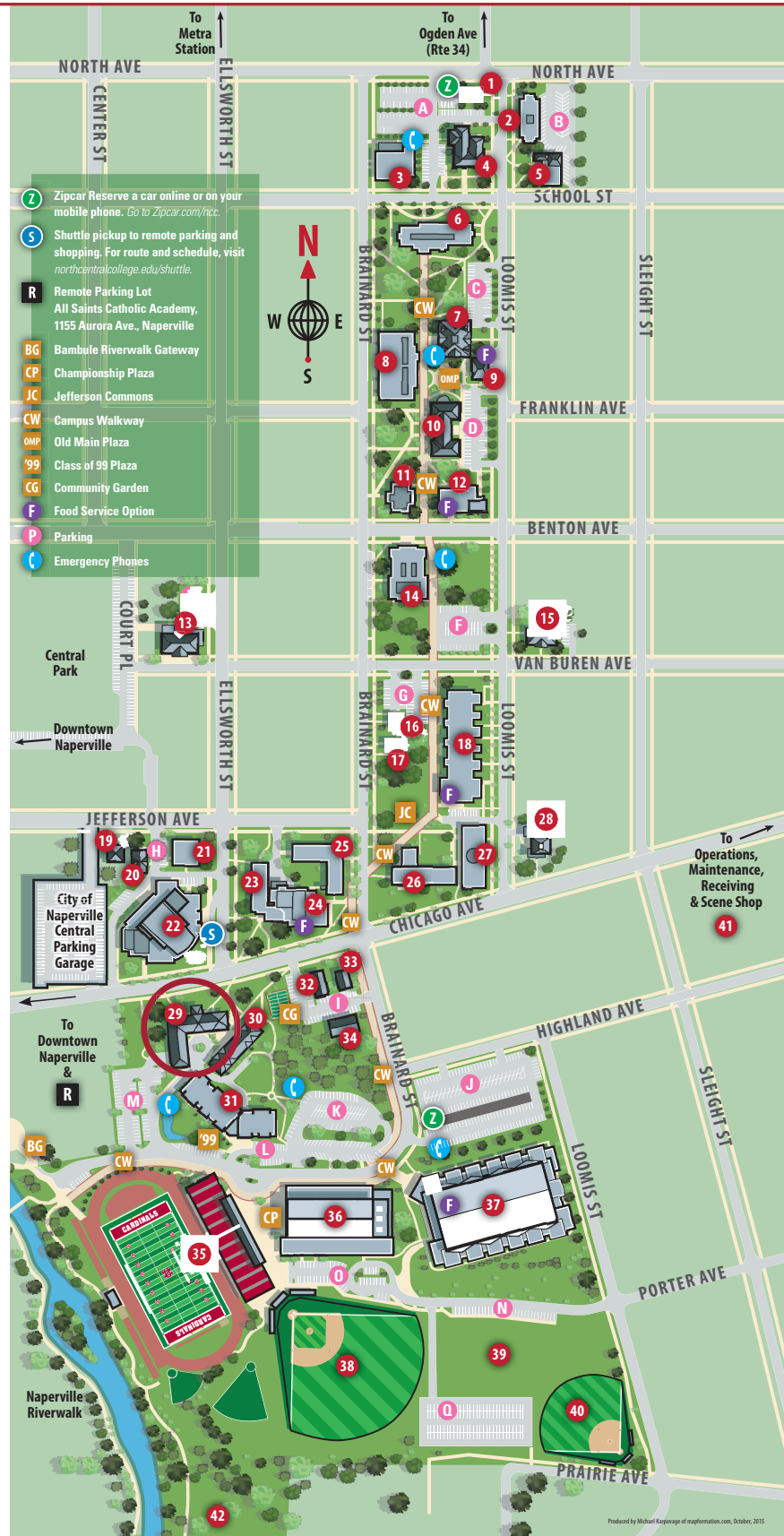
The International Living and Learning Community is located in Patterson Hall at 180 E. Chicago Ave., Naperville, IL.
