At North Central College, graduate students are eligible for federal and private financial aid, most commonly federal student loans. In order to qualify, a student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually and include our school code 001734.

The maximum amount a graduate student can borrow under the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan program is \$20,500 per year, with a maximum lifetime limit of \$138,500, which includes undergraduate federal direct loan borrowing. A student may also apply for a Graduate PLUS Loan to cover any other educational cost.

All estimated expenses vary by student. It is encouraged that students consider opportunities to minimize other cost and borrowing.
