- Visit Aran Islands and the Cliffs of Moher

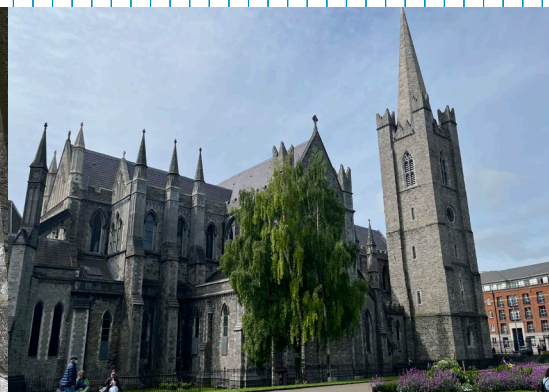

Course Description:

In this course, we will analyze Irish cultural identity both here, in the Republic of Ireland, and in Northern Ireland. We will explore social, economic, and political factors that have shaped the island's history and created a global diaspora. A core part will focus on how museums and cultural institutions tell stories about what it means to be Irish.

Enrollment Steps:

To participate in a CDCA, you must enroll in and successfully complete its prerequisite course.

- Register ON MERLIN for the CDCA one-credit travel component in summer session (designated course section on the flipside of this flyer).

Enrollment Deadline: November 1, 2023
(or before, if course capacity is met).

Center for Global Education (CGE) Registration:

- **November 1, 2023:** Students enrolled in a CDCA will begin the registration process, be charged a non-refundable \$40 registration fee, and prompted to pay the non-refundable \$500 program fee deposit through the Center for Global Education.
- **January 19, 2024:** Proof of a valid passport is due. (Current passports must be valid through November 2024 for May term travel, six (6) months past your return travel date.)

INCLUDES:

NOT INCLUDED:

- Meals (other than those listed in the itinerary),
- Optional entertainment and excursions,
- Excess baggage charges,
- Personal items (telephone charges, laundry fees, room service, souvenirs, etc.),
- Departure taxes (except U.S.),
- Passport fees

Payment Deadlines:

- **December 15, 2023:**
\$500 non-refundable program fee deposit due to North Central College
- **January 19, 2024:**
\$500 non-refundable airfare deposit due to North Central College
- **March 2024:**
Remaining program fee balance (including airfare) will be billed to your NC student account

CDCA Tuition

- All May Term CDCAs are worth one (1) academic credit.
- Students are responsible for paying the one (1) credit tuition fee, which is built into the program fee cost.
- Multiple CDCA Scholarships applications will be available through the Center for Global Education in October 2023.
