Course Description:

This course offers a multidisciplinary approach to learning about the environmental issues Spain faces in protecting its treasured history, culture, and environment. Students will embark on a high-paced journey through Spain that will take them back in time to discover the historical imprints of great civilizations and spectacular natural landscapes. Students will explore and engage in the innovative sustainable measures taken to preserve UNESCO World Heritage sites, including classical Roman aqueducts, medieval palaces, Muslim mosques, Christian churches, treasured art collections, underground wine cellars, mountainous caves, flora and fauna biosphere reserves, and diverse urban spaces impacted by the economy, tourism, and pollution.

Enrollment Steps:

To participate in a CDCA, you must enroll in and successfully complete its prerequisite course.

- Register ON MERLIN for the CDCA one-credit travel component in summer session (designated course section on the flipside of this flyer).

Enrollment Deadline: November 1, 2023

(or before, if course capacity is met).

Center for Global Education (CGE) Registration:

- **November 1, 2023:** Students enrolled in a CDCA will begin the registration process, be charged a non-refundable \$40 registration fee, and prompted to pay the non-refundable \$500 program fee deposit, through the Center for Global Education.
- **January 19, 2024:** Proof of a valid passport is due. *(Current passports must be valid through November 2024 for May term travel, six (6) months past your return travel date.)*

Payment Deadlines:

Remaining program fee balance (including airfare) will be billed to your NC Student Account

CDCA Tuition

- All May Term CDCAs are worth one (1) academic credit.
- Students are responsible for paying the one (1) credit tuition fee, which is built into the program fee cost.
