Enrollment Steps:

To participate in a Cardinal Destination Course Abroad (CDCA), you must enroll in and successfully complete its prerequisite work.

Enrollment Deadline: November 1, 2024 (or before, if course capacity is met).

Center for Global Education (CGE) Registration:

- November 1, 2024: Students enrolled in a CDCA will begin the registration process, be charged a non-refundable \$40 registration fee, and prompted to pay the non-refundable \$500 program fee deposit, through the Center for Global Education.
- January 19, 2025: Proof of a <u>valid</u> passport is due. (Current passports must be valid through November 2025 for May term travel, six (6) months past your return travel date.)
