- Official documentation of English proficiency, including English test scores, approved coursework, successful completion of the Intensive English Program, etc.

English Language Institute (ELI)

Two ELI Programs:

Intensive English Program

- Non-credit bearing classes
- Serves high-beginning and low-advanced level students
- Two levels: one or two semester program
- Conditionally admitted students begin studies here

Excel Program

- Credit-bearing coursework (2-12 credits)
- Serves advanced-level students
- 8 week courses; one semester program
