Course Description:

This course explores the history of globalization and democracy across Europe. That story, and our travel, begins in Greece, the birthplace of democracy. It then continues to Italy, where we will examine how Renaissance thinkers similarly grappled with classical notions of democracy. All of which will culminate in an examination of the European Union's institutions of economic and political integration as well as the anti-democratic forces seeking to pull that very system apart.





Enrollment Steps:

Center for Global Education (CGE) Registration:

- November 1, 2025: Students enrolled in a CDCA will begin the registration process, be charged a non-refundable \$40 registration fee, and prompted to pay the non-refundable \$500 program fee deposit, through the Center for Global Education.
- January 19, 2026: Proof of a <u>valid</u> passport is due. (Current passports must be valid through November 2026 for May term travel, six (6) months past your return travel date.)
