**Enrollment Deadline: November 1, 2025** (or before, if course capacity is met)

# Center for Global Education (CGE) Registration:

- November 1, 2025: Students enrolled in a CDCA will begin the registration process, be charged a non-refundable \$40 registration fee, and prompted to pay the non-refundable \$500 program fee deposit, through the Center for Global Education.
- January 19, 2026: Proof of a <u>valid</u> passport is due. (Current passports must be valid through November 2026 for May term travel, six (6) months past your return travel date.)
